Hahndorf Rifle Club welcomes all those that are interested in historical service rifle, to the annual ANZAC Day memorial competition, which will be conducted in respect to all those that landed and fought on the beachhead of ANZAC cove in 1915.

Competition details

All shooters will use a historical reproduction "tin hat" target that was used for training during the Where: Hahndorf Rifle Club Range (corner early 20th Century, set at 200 yards. Maximum score will be set at 100 points, shot over SA).

2 details of 10 shots (with 2 optional sighters).

ONLY standard issue rifles are eligible for the memorial trophy (all non standard issue rifles; either modified or accurised, are eligible to compete, but will be shooting for the honour of shooting, rather than for entering for winnings).

Further Information

All rifles and ammunition must be presented and cleared to use prior to entering into the competition, and must be pre zeroed prior to the beginning of the competition, as sighting in immediately prior to the beginning of the competition will not be allowed due to time restraints.

All standard issue or faithful reproduction rifles and training rifles will compete on an even ground, these must be in standard issue configuration, all modifications may change the class and eligibility to the rifle which may include (but not limited to the following), Range based sights, stainless or any non standard barrels, modified stocks which does not fit as a standard issue for the rifle.

Limited Pre zeroed rifles will be available for hire (rifles will be signed off to an individual and returned in a complete and issued condition).

The shoot will be ran under the current Hahndorf Rifle Club COVID management plan.

Competition structure

- Each shooter will compete under the current HRC service rifle SSR (standardised shooting rules).
- Each detail will include a maximum of 12 rounds, where 2 optional sighters will be allowed with 10 sequential scoring shots counted.
- Each shooter will have a maximum of 45 seconds per shot once the target is hoisted.
- All shots will be either done from a Prone Unsupported or a sitting unsupported position and can remain in position throughout their
- At the discipline captains discression, handicapped new shooters and junior shooters may use a simple wrist wrest to assist with their shooting.

PLEASE NOTE

If any shooter fails to hit the target in two successive shots, they will be asked withdraw from the competition due to concerns of frame damage.
